****Things you need to know and BRING for the Club 56 Adventure Park USA Trip on May 2nd!****

- Bus will leave from Temple immediately after Sunday School and pick up students from Bindeman. We will provide snacks and activities at Bindeman while we wait for the bus to arrive.
- **Pick-up after the program is at Bindeman at 5:30 p.m. The bus will NOT return to Temple.**
- **Please RSVP no later than April 28th!** We need to have enough staff to go around with each small group of students so your RSVPs are vital!
- **This event is also open to 4th graders so they can try out Club 56 and get excited for next year!**
- **PLEASE BRING A BAG LUNCH!** In order to maximize our time at Adventure Park we will not be providing lunch. Students should bring a bag lunch or they may buy their own food at the park.
- Please consider bringing a towel and/or dry clothes as the bumper boats are very fun and very wet!
- Additional attractions (Go Karts, Bumper Boats, etc.) may be purchased that day for \$4 each (a discounted rate for our group). Additional arcade credits may also be purchased.
- Students will be able to pick 2 attractions: Go Karts (two car sizes based on height), Bumper Boats, Ropes Course, and Rock Wall. They also get unlimited mini-golf plus 30 arcade credits. Please make sure your child understands that while the park offers it, our students are **not permitted** to do Laser Tag or Paint Ball.
