February 26th at Temple

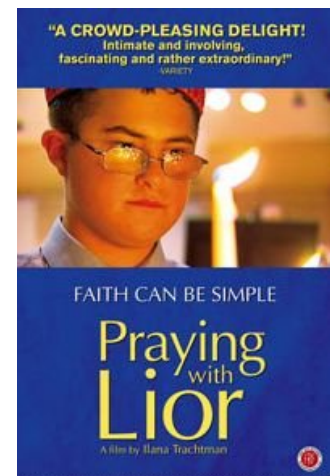
Often it takes an appreciation of Jewish culture to fully understand Judaism. We invite you to join us for **Sundays at Seven** where each month our rabbinic staff will facilitate a discussion as we explore a different film or book with a Jewish theme—always on Sundays and always at 7:00 pm!

In recognition of Jewish Disability Awareness Month, the Interfaith/Outreach Committee will screen *Praying with Lior* at Temple on Sunday, February 26th. Rabbi Shankman will lead a post-film discussion.

This powerful documentary produced and directed by Ilana Trachtman, daughter of WHC member and Back to Basics instructor Gerdy Trachtman, introduces the audience to Lior Liebling. Lior, also known as “the little rebbe,” is approaching his Bar Mitzvah and seems to have a unique connection with God. He also has Down syndrome.

Filmmaker Trachtman says, “Lior’s story presents a dramatic opportunity to demonstrate the contribution that every individual can make, no matter how “special.” While society may view inclusion as the right or nice thing to do, Lior’s example shows us that his presence actually enhances everyone else’s religious experience.” *Praying with Lior* has won several awards, including Grand Prize, 2010 International Disability Film Festival and Best Documentary from the 2008 San Diego, Seattle and Vancouver Film Festivals.

All congregants are welcome to attend this event. This poignant film is appropriate for pre- and post-B’nai Mitzvah students. Popcorn and drinks will be served!
