

Annual Contribution Schedule For Members Age 35 and Under

Persons age 35 and under are invited to join the Congregation at the following level of annual contribution:

*Age 29 and under	\$150
Ages 30 thru 32	\$200
Ages 33 thru 35	\$250

*Children of current Washington Hebrew Congregation members are not required to make an annual contribution until the age of 30. If married, the age of the older spouse is used to determine the amount of their contribution.

At age 36 the members place themselves in the Fair Share Program. This means an annual contribution will be made based on total household income and the appropriate CF (Capital Fund) pledge will be made payable over five to ten (5-10) years. Our philosophy is not to deny membership to anyone who wishes to join Washington Hebrew Congregation.

Members, for whom this schedule creates a hardship, may call Lan Swerdloff, Membership Coordinator, at the Temple office, 202-362-7100 and request an adjustment form. All requests for dues adjustments are reviewed by our Membership Committee.

Note: Should a member on this Special Schedule enroll a child in either the Religious School or Early Childhood Center, the Fair Share Dues Program will be in effect.
