How You and Your Congregation Can Support Friendship Place's AimHire Efforts

Friendship Place has learned from years of experience that jobs and housing go hand in hand. Without a job, housing is impossible to sustain. AimHire Friendship Place helps our DC neighbors get hired and stay employed, creating a stable pathway out of homelessness.

AimHire is supported through robust volunteer engagement. These are some of the many ways congregations and their members can support AimHire participants.

Mentoring. Work one-on-one via Zoom with participants to sharpen their resumes and interview skills. The time commitment is approximately 1-2 hours weekly, biweekly or monthly, depending on your availability.

Scouting Job Opportunities. Are you aware of employment opportunities in your workplace or community? Take the time to share them with our staff and participants. Send leads to the email address below.

Serving as an Ambassador to Local Employers: Are there business owners or hiring managers in your congregation or your personal networks? Please introduce our staff to those who might be in a position to hire our participants. Positions in admin, food service, janitorial, maintenance, and construction are most commonly a fit for our participants, but AimHire welcomes information on job openings of any type.
